Theme 1 (Weeks 2 – 11)

THEME DESCRIPTION: An inquiry into the nature of the self, beliefs and values.

CENTRAL IDEA: Awareness of change contributes to our understanding of ourselves.

LINES OF INQUIRY: Changes through puberty; respecting people's differences through changing relationships.

KEY and RELATED CONCEPTS: Change, growth and identity.

LEARNER PROFILES: Balanced, reflective, confident and respectful.

APPROACHES TO LEARNING: Self-management and social skills.



Literacy is fully integrated into our themes. This term we will be looking into processes, strategies and ideas. The students will be reading for understanding and communicating their own ideas on a range of topics.

Mathematics - In Maths this term we will be starting with number knowledge during week 2-4 and moving on to measurement and geometry week 5-10. Maths will be integrated where and when appropriate.
