Transdisciplinary Theme

'How the World Works'

Central Idea: All life is connected to the natural systems of the planet/universe

Lines of Inquiry

- Cyclic nature of the planet
- The interdependence of life forms
- The effects and consequences of change



Literacy is fully integrated into our themes and we are excited about the history focus. In the first half of this term, we are writing a piece of historical fiction around a significant event or person. Our focus will be around creating atmosphere by improving character development and setting the scene in our imaginative writing. In the second half of the term, we will be focusing on our ability to recount and explain through writing diary entries and letters in the style of historical figures.



Mathematics - In Maths, we will be revisiting number knowledge throughout the term, covering any gaps in students learning.

Maths will be integrated where and when appropriate throughout the curriculum.

Specialisation

Technology and the Arts - These will be fully integrated throughout our themes and include Digital Technology - using software packages students will create their own animations , Art and Design - Designing and creating their own mythical creature, Soft and Hard Technology as well as Food Technology.

Language - Students will begin to understand more complicated instructions and sentences in French with Madame Jasmine Hanaway, and will have two forty-five minute sessions each week. We will also continue Te Reo lessons with Mr Mauri Hohepa on Tuesday's every week.
