Other Learning Areas

<u>Study Skills-</u> To help the students be in the best position for their transition to high school we spend the first 2 weeks teaching the students about studying for tests. Students will be sitting literacy and math practise exams in Week 2, they will be given the content to study in Week 1. They will be sitting these in a lecture theatre at the university.

<u>Literacy</u> Literacy is fully integrated into our themes. This term we are looking at different forms of persuasive texts.

For Exhibition, we will learn about advertising and how these are created to persuade others. The students will use these ideas to create adverts to sell their idea for Exhibition.

<u>Mathematics</u>- The students will be working on Geometry and Measurement. In Measurement, students will be learning ways to measure time, space and angles.

In Geometry, students will explore shapes and the transformations these go through.
